HHH SEPTA Executive Board Positions

Most Executive Board Positions require attendance at a Half Hollow Hills PTA Council District meeting once a month and a follow up verbal report at our monthly SEPTA meetings. Please read descriptions for more information. All meetings are virtual at this time. Meeting dates are on the HHH School Calendar:

(2) Council Delegates: Attend council meetings, record minutes and attend District Committee meeting(s) if the representatives are unable to attend. Then provide a verbal report at our monthly SEPTA Meeting.

School Building Representatives (2 for each HHH School Building) Attend SEPTA Meetings to provide information of upcoming events at their school. Attend home school/ children's school PTA meetings and inform Unit of HHH SEPTA events.

BUDGET: Members are provided with information about the HHH District school budget. Meeting includes members of the Board of Education and Administration. This meeting is generally held on a Thursday morning.

COMMUNITY AWARENESS: Members discuss important issues of concern to the HHH community such as safety, environment, zoning and traffic issues. May be involved in mobilizing the PTA for action on certain issues. This meeting is usually held on a Monday morning.

DIVERSITY: This committee works to promote cultural respect and understanding in regard to the vast diversity of cultures in our district. Members assist in organizing the district-wide Unity Fair. Meets once a month usually on Thursday mornings at 10am.

EDUCATION: Educate the PTA on the various concerns related to educational issues. Curriculum, class size, legislation and its effects on education, etc. are discussed at monthly meeting. This meeting is usually held on a Friday morning at 10am

FACILITIES: Committee meets to discuss the condition and use of school grounds and buildings in the district. This meeting is generally held on a Friday morning.

LEGISLATION: Participate in idea sharing discussions on current trends in legislation and how it impacts our children. Members help organize district wide "Meet the Candidate Night." Lobby local and state officials to inform them of PTA stance on key issues. This meeting does not have a standard day or time.

PARENT RESOURCE CENTER/ TASK FORCE (PRC): Brings issues of concern to parents, educating them through workshops on a variety of topics. Examples of such workshops include discipline, homework skills, bullying and raising drug-free children. The majority of these meetings are during the day on a Tuesday but additional day and night meetings do occur.

PUBLICITY: Maintain and update HHH SEPTA website on a weekly/bi-weekly basis. Participate in monthly on-line meetings. There is one in person meeting in September. Meetings are usually on line on Friday mornings.

SCHOOL BOARD REPRESENTATIVES: Attend evening School Board meetings which are held monthly at district schools. Be the first to find out what is happening in our district! This meeting is usually held on a Monday evening.

TRANSPORTATION: School bus safety issues are addressed as well as bus routes, and transportation laws. Act as a liaison for parents with transportation concerns/problems in the district. This meeting is usually held on Thursday mornings.

WHOLE HEALTH: Committee promotes student wellness with school lunch improvements, elevates awareness of healthy snack choices, allergy awareness and the importance of physical activity. Meetings are held once a month on a Tuesday at 1pm.
