# How to participate in The Great Jack-o'-Lantern Sail

1. **Call (631) 321-3510 to register for Pumpkin drop off.**
2. **Purchase a pumpkin between 5lbs—10lbs.**  
Not sure how big that is? It should be no larger than a basketball.
3. **Carve your Jack-o'-Lantern at home.**  
The pumpkin must be cut from the top NOT the bottom, gutted, and carved. Any decorations must be made of natural, biodegradable materials. Do not add lightbulbs, candles or floats; a flameless LED tea light and floating device will be provided.
4. **Drop-off your carved Jack-o'-Lantern on Saturday, October 27 between 10:00am & 2:00pm at the Belmont Lake State Park boat dock.**  
Please be advised that Jack-o'-Lanterns will NOT be returned after the sail. Space to participate is limited to 50 Jack-o'-Lanterns; pumpkins that do not meet the requirements for participation, or are dropped off after 50 floats have been filled, will be put on display (space permitting) during the event and will not be included in the sail.
5. **Enjoy the event!**  
A variety of FREE children's activities will be offered from 3:00 - 6:00PM. And, don't forget your Halloween costume!
6. **Choose your seat and watch the sail!**  
Once activities close, find a spot along the north edge of Belmont Lake and watch the Great Jack-o'-Lantern Sail!
