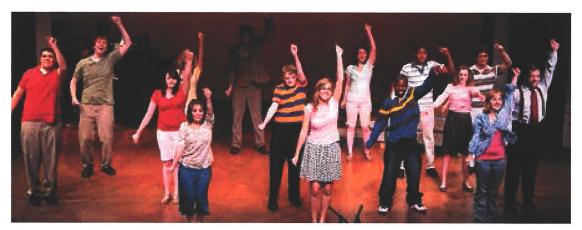

All ages welcome but under 5 MUST have an adult with them at all times.

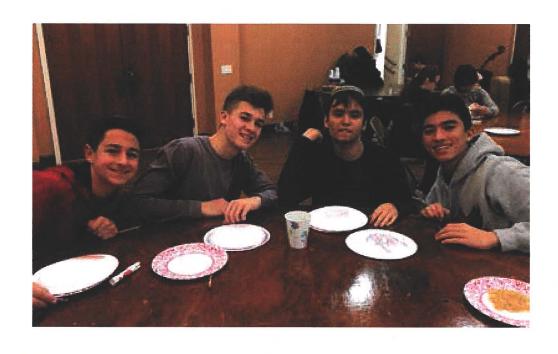

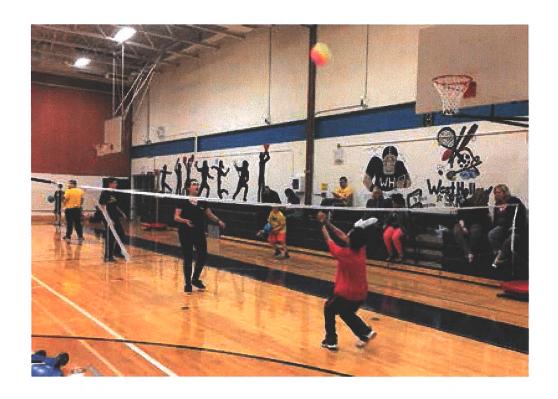

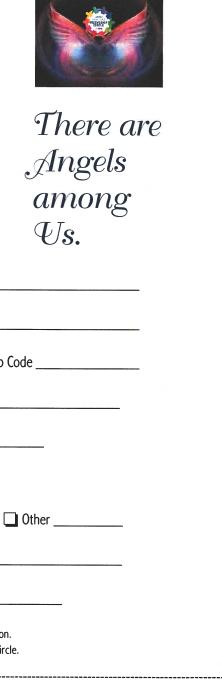
